Metolius Drive Project Update

The phase 2 work is going much faster than anticipated. The following information is from the contractor project manager today.

Received Thursday September 8, 2011 -

All roads will be fully open for the weekend. On Monday we will go to stage 3 of the detour closing Metolius to the East from Devils Lake.

With the wrap up of phase 2, residents will not be delayed by flaggers at the neighborhood entrance. The contractor estimates a faster than originally planned phase 3 at approximately 3 weeks.

Please note that phase 3 does mean coming and going via Metolius through Tetherow. The city does not intend to setup detour signs at the Mt Washington/Metolius intersection. USPS, UPS and FedEx are aware of this situation. Remember to notify other companies if you have a service call scheduled.

Miller Elementary Bus Pick Up and Drop Off Information

While the school district Operations Manager told me the bus would not come into the neighborhood during the Metolius construction, the bus has been in the neighborhood this week. As phase 3 approaches Monday September 12, the bus will not pick up students in our neighborhood during this phase.

Please use the morning West Ridge stop at 7:38am or another option is the Broken Top park/security gate at 8:30.
